### **Inaugural young couples encounter**

**Saturday the 25th of February 2017 saw the inaugural young couples encounter event within our community held at the Sacred Heart Church in Leicester. No doubt such an event had been long overdue. It had been duly noted that with so many of our mature youths graduating into courtships and marriages there was need for couples spiritual formation and guidance.**

**More than 15 young couples attended the day long workshop. The event was held under the theme of Romans 12, verses 1-2. 3 mature couples were invited to share their marriage experiences and offer advice as well as addressing questions from the young couples. The 3 mature couple speakers were, The Madimus (senior), The Chikashas and The Nyaguyos.**

**The speakers all offered the young couples in attendance on the day a unique opportunity to review, deepen and re-evaluate their growing relationships. Overall the program helped couples to realise the conditions required for a life of love, joy, and growth in accordance with the vocational sacrament of marriage. Fr Magugu was on**

hand to offer spiritual guidance throughout the day with Sekuru Mudoti and Tete Zenda co-facilitating.

The idea of a young couples encounter as opposed to a specific marriage encounter-as is usually the set up in parishes back home was deliberate. Indeed the event was open to all young couples in our community who were wedded, traditionally, civilly, in holy matrimony or couples in courtship. The mixed set up was received very positively and going forward the general consensus was to maintain the same fluid structure. The day ended with a brief brainstorm of future encounters both social and spiritual reflecting the general appetite and thirst for the group amongst its members.
